

The Coming Eschatological Revolution

I. JESUS' END-TIME PLAN

- A. The primary theme in the Book of Revelation is Jesus coming back to take over all the nations.
⁷ Behold, He is coming with clouds, and every eye will see Him, even they who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn because of Him. Even so, Amen. (Rev. 1:7)
¹⁵ The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord...¹⁸ The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come...destroy those who destroy the earth. (Rev. 11:15-18)
- B. A transitional generation is a unique time in history when the majority of God's people witness His power on a regular basis with a major shift in how God relates to His people. There are 3 "transitional generations" in history: Moses (Ex. 7-10), Apostles (Acts) and Revelation. It is the Moses dynamic of military and political and the Paul dynamic of spiritual salvation and healing.
- C. In the generation the Lord returns, the most comprehensive revolution in history will unfold including God's power and activities in Exodus and Acts combined and multiplied on a global scale. The greatest demonstration of both God's and Satan's power will be released worldwide.
- D. The most unique aspect of God's action plan as seen in Exodus is the supernatural way in which the physical dimension of the conflict was waged. For example, Moses engaged in a military conflict with Pharaoh that released weapons that destroyed Pharaoh's might in a physical way. The weapons were released from heaven through prayer without the aid of physical military equipment. Moses released ten supernatural "missiles" or destructive strikes from heaven.
- E. The most powerful force in the coming eschatological revolution is the praying Church. The prayer of the saints will release a supernatural arsenal from heaven that will parallel the miracles of Egypt (Mic. 7:15; Isa. 10:22-25; 11:12-16; 30:30; Jer. 16:14-15; 23:7-8; Ezek. 38:22).
¹⁵ As in the days when you came out of...Egypt, I will show them wonders. (Mic. 7:15)
- F. Understanding will be given by the Spirit to the End-Time Church so they have love instead of anger and offense at Jesus, clarity instead of confusion, and peace instead of fear.
¹⁹ A whirlwind of the Lord has gone forth in fury -- a violent whirlwind! It will fall violently on the...wicked. ²⁰ The anger of the Lord will not turn back until He has executed...the thoughts of His heart. In the latter days you will understand it perfectly. (Jer. 23:19-20)
²⁴ The fierce anger of the LORD will not return until He has done it, and until He has performed the intents of His heart. In the latter days you will consider it. (Jer. 30:24)
³³ Those of the people who understand shall instruct many... they shall fall by sword and flame, by captivity and plundering....³⁵ Some of those of understanding shall fall (martyrdom), to refine them, purify them...until the time of the end (Dan. 11:33-35)

II. OUR 3-FOLD MANDATE: INTIMACY, INTERCESSION, FORERUNNER MESSENGERS

The Bride is making herself ready to partner with Jesus for an eschatological Revolution (Rev. 19:7)

- A. He is preparing a Bride in love, wisdom and power to partner with Him as He opens the seals. Most have no clear anticipation of Jesus' End-Time action plan, thus no intentional preparation. Some who anticipate Jesus' End-Time action plan romanticize the future.

⁷ *For the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready. (Rev. 19:7)*

⁷ *Shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out day and night...⁸ Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith (agreement) on the earth? (Lk. 18:7-8)*

¹ *Who is this who comes from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah...traveling in the greatness of His strength?...² Why is Your apparel red, and Your garments like one who treads in the winepress? ³ "I have trodden the winepress alone, and from the peoples no one was with Me. For I have trodden them in My anger...their blood is sprinkled upon My garments...⁴ For the day of vengeance is in My heart, and the year of My redeemed has come. ⁵ I looked, but there was no one to help, I wondered that there was no one to uphold....⁶ I have trodden down the peoples in My anger, made them drunk in My fury... (Isa. 63:1-6)*

- B. *Intimacy (Father/Bridegroom):* experiencing God's emotions (desire, tenderness, joy, zeal)
MESSAGE: Abandonment (2-fold): God's "abandonment" in loving us as He loves Himself (Jn. 15:9; 17:23) and our heart abandoned in love for God in as the First Commandment is restored to first place and walked out in Sermon on the Mount lifestyles.
1). *Tender*: confidence in God's love even in our weakness
2). *Delight*: exhilarated by God's emotions of affection, joy and gladness
3). *Jealousy*: spirit of abandonment (First Commandment) releasing Jesus' zealous judgments
4). *Fascination*: God's majesty and wisdom plan to establish love on earth in partnership with us
- C. *Intercession (King):* releasing God's power (imparting what is good)
MESSAGE: Transformation (church/society/government) by releasing revival (worldwide harvest), the healing anointing of Jn. 14:12, the transfer of wealth (marketplace); justice in government (righteous leaders and laws), compassion in society (orphans/poor/human trafficking, aids, etc.) and the salvation of Israel
- D. *Forerunner Messengers (Judge):* confronting what hinders love (removing what is bad)
MESSAGE: Revolution (God's End-Time action plan in the Book of Revelation) preparing the church to partner in the unique dynamics of releasing eschatological judgment on the Antichrist's worldwide empire with global corporate imprecatory prayers
- E. Summary: train up [forerunner messengers](#) like John the Baptist who will operate in the "[friend of the Bridegroom](#)" spirit of Elijah in preparing people for the coming of the Lord as Bridegroom, King and Judge who will orchestrate an eschatological shift of history.
